**As an extension of the 2026 Festival Under the Stars (February 13 to March 15),  
Opera Naples plans to conclude performance season with intimate concert  
featuring renowned mezzo-soprano on April 7**

**NAPLES, FL (January 20, 2026)** – Opera Naples is pleased to announce the addition of a special concert to its 2025/26 season: an intimate recital featuring acclaimed mezzo-soprano Samantha Hankey on April 7, 2026, at Moorings Presbyterian Church. A much sought after recitalist who has been praised by the *Financial Times* for her “much elegance and youthful tone,” Hankey has enjoyed a rapidly rising career with appearances at The Metropolitan Opera, Vienna State Opera, Royal Opera House, Lyric Opera of Chicago, Chicago Symphony Orchestra, Boston Symphony Orchestra, Carnegie Hall and The Kennedy Center, among other premier performance halls around the world. Hankey will be joined for this performance by Opera Naples Artistic and Music Director Ramón Tebar at the piano. Maestro Tebar commented, “I have been following Samantha’s career for some years now, and she is an artist I wanted very much to perform with. When I found out that she spent many summers in Naples during childhood, I couldn’t resist adding a performance with her as soon as possible.
